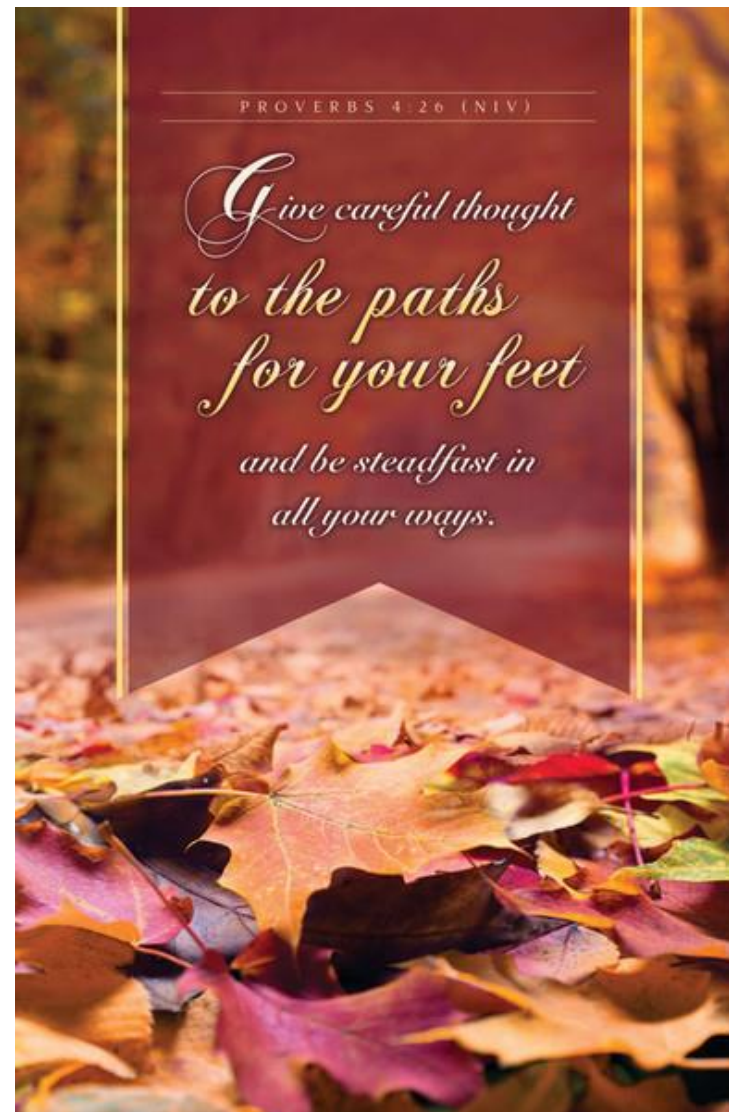

USPS Mail - mail your check to Blue Ridge UMC, 235 Orvin Lance Dr, Blue Ridge, GA 30513

Bill Pay - If you do online banking, you can set your church contribution through Bill Pay

Church mailbox - Our mailbox is locked and there is a slot at the top where you can drop your contribution but please put it in an envelope before dropping it off - facing the church the mailbox is located at the entrance nearest the Credit Union maybe 25 ft toward the church from the church sign (it is a drive up mailbox)

PayPal - Pastor Jay has put a button on our website that allows you to contribute via PayPal but there is a service charge (approximately 3%) that PayPal charges so the contribution the church received is 3% less
